## SETTING UP

Set up the PlayStation®3 system according to the instructions in its instruction manual.  
At start-up, the power indicator light will glow red to indicate that the PlayStation®3 system is in Standby Mode.  
Press the power button and the power indicator light will turn green.

Insert the Darksiders 2 disc into the disc slot with the label side facing upwards. Select the icon from the XMB™ Menu and press the button to continue. Make sure there is enough free space on the Hard Disk Drive (HDD) before commencing play. Do not insert or remove peripherals once the power is turned on.

Please refer to the PlayStation®3 system's instruction manual for further details about setting up and recharging a Wireless Controller.

## GETTING STARTED

### PlayStation®3 SYSTEM

**Starting a game:** Before use, carefully read the instructions supplied with the PlayStation®3 computer entertainment system. The documentation contains information on setting up and using your system as well as important safety information.

Check that the MAIN POWER switch (located on the system rear) is turned on. Insert the *DARKSIDERS® II* disc with the label facing up into the disc slot. Select the icon for the software title under  in the XMB™ menu, and then press the  button. Refer to this manual for information on using the software.

**Quitting a game:** During gameplay, press and hold down the  button on the wireless controller for at least 2 seconds. Then select "Quit Game" from the screen that is displayed.

#### Hint

To remove a disc, touch the eject button after quitting the game.



**Trophies:** Earn, compare and share trophies that you earn by making specific in-game accomplishments. Trophies access requires a PlayStation®Network account.

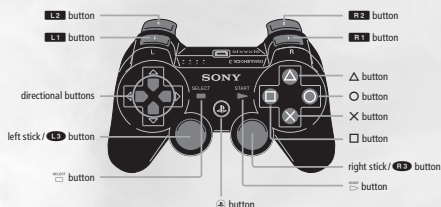
### SAVED DATA

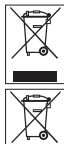
